- Perform architecture analysis to inform invest and divest decisions
- Apply conceptual and logical data architecture concepts; collaborating on and coordinating changes to data models
- Support Architecture integration sessions with architecture skill center staff, customer stakeholders, industry, and contractor support personnel
- Develop architectural assessments, presentations, white papers and other analyses, as required
- Communicate architecture concepts and demonstrate value to customers not versed in architecture principles
- Attend and brief architecture review boards, serving as a team member simultaneously supporting development of multiple products across the GEA
