Oversees the development, integration, and exercising of AT plans and policy. Provides strategic direction, vision, and leadership. Demonstrates considerable expertise in providing solutions and recommendations based on internal and external factors. Monitors plans and exercises, assesses plan effectiveness, and recommends plan improvements to improve responses to emergencies. Cognizant of national and DNI policies and provides expertise to act as trusted advisor to NGA senior leadership. Able to provide strategic direction in leading activities in support of team and enterprise objectives.
